

Rules

1. The garden is open from dawn to dusk. These are the hours of Marymoor Park.
2. The garden is for use by its members only for organic gardening. Gardening at Marymoor Community Garden is a strictly non-profit activity and growing vegetables and flowers for commercial use is prohibited.
3. Storage, use, or disposal of hazardous substances at Marymoor Community Garden ("MCG") is prohibited by Marymoor Park. These include:
 - Synthetic pesticides and herbicides such as Roundup and Corry's Slug & Snail Death
 - Raw animal manure – manures must be fully composted
 - Human waste
 - Petroleum products such as gasoline and diesel fuel.
 - Standing water that can become a breeding ground for bacteria, parasites, and pests.
4. Removing vegetables, flowers, or garden equipment from a plot without the gardener's consent is prohibited. Modifying another gardener's plot without their permission is also prohibited.
5. Using loudspeakers is prohibited, except by permit from the Marymoor Park office.
6. Gardeners must be present in their plots while watering.
7. The use of automatic water timers is prohibited.
8. Using MCGA water for anything other than garden support activities is strictly prohibited.
9. Permanent structures are prohibited. A permanent structure is defined to be one that requires concrete or is not removable. Fences and raised beds are permitted, so long as they can be easily removed.
10. Using tires to build garden containers and structures is prohibited by Marymoor Park and by King County.
11. Do not block the roads or the garden paths.
12. Do not dump weeds or garbage anywhere except in the designated bins on the west end of the garden area.
